Date: February 26th

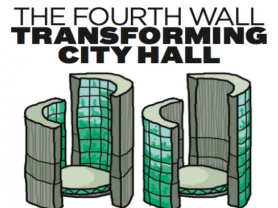
Time: 6:30pm
